

Table Talk Feb 7, 2011

Match Committee met on Sunday Feb 6, 2011 to review format for the team league playoffs. Playoffs will start on Feb 16 and finish on March 31 which is 7 weeks. There will be 3 divisions with 8 teams in two divisions and 7 in one division. The divisions are made up of teams with top, medium or lower finishes during regular season. One of three top teams will be in each division. It will be a round robin format. The division with 7 teams will have one bye. At end of season there will be a page format for each division with second place team playing third place. The winner then plays team number one. There will be 3 teams advance to finals where they will play each team to determine club champion for 2011.

If there are ties in the playoffs, there will be an extra end with each player delivering one stone. There will be a 2 rock rule instead of a 4 rock before a rock can be removed from play. For the finals teams will play an extra end to determine the winner. No schedule can be posted till the final results from the regular season are known. A schedule will be done then and copies available.
